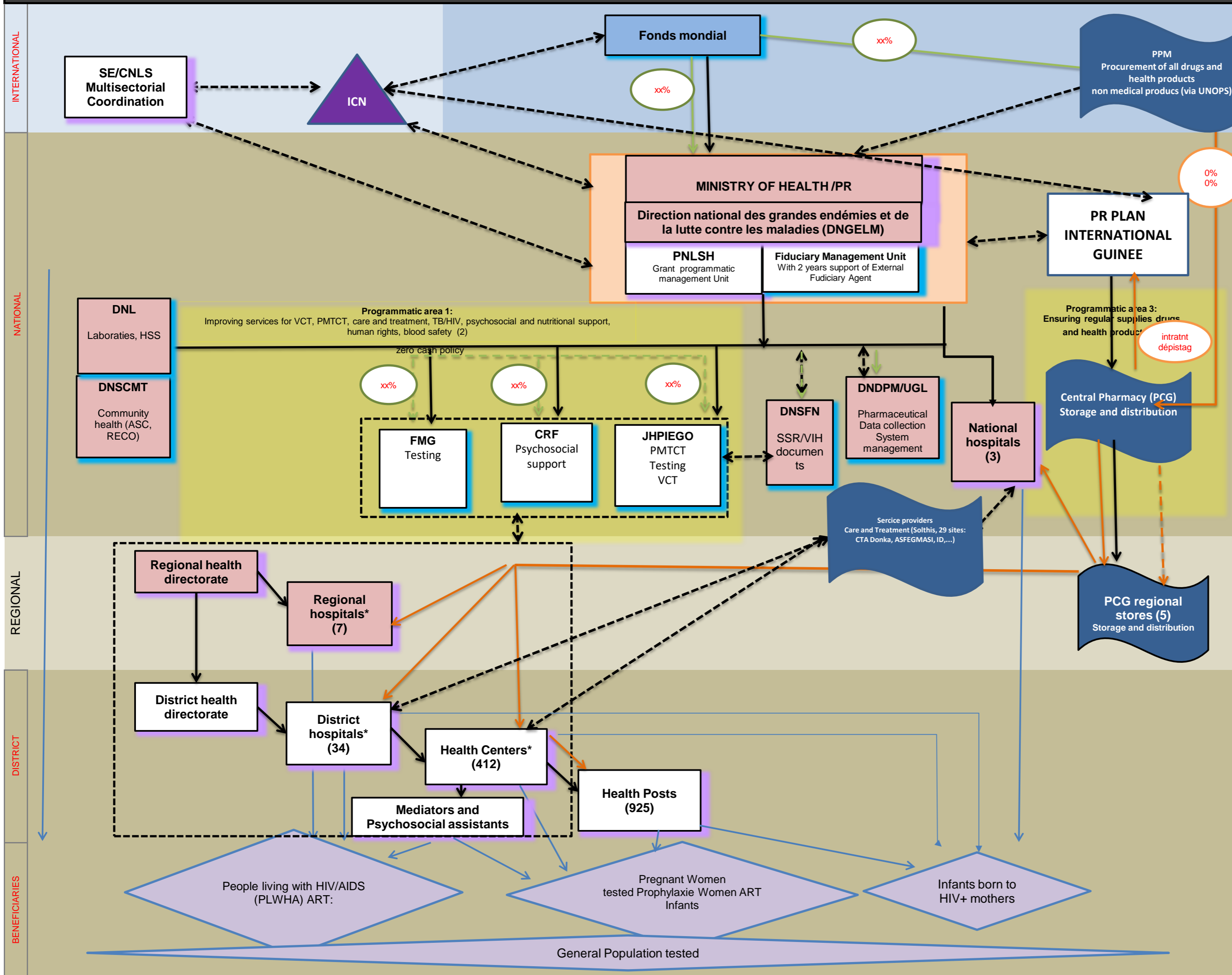

**(1) PR responsibilities:**

- Quantification and tracking of stocks of pharmaceuticals and health
- Procurement of medical and non-medical equipment
- M&E (training, studies)

**(3) Description of activities (implemented by IE or SR) :**

- Training of mediators, health workers, lab technicians, pharmacist in VCT, PMTCT, care and treatment, TB/HIV, psychosocial and nutritional support
- Development of guidelines, production of data collection tools
- Supervisions of VCT, PMTCT, treatment sites

**(4) Description of activities (implemented by PR):**

- Procurement of medical equipment as part of new grant activities

**(5) Description of activities (overseen by PR):**

- Procurement, storage and distribution of drugs and health products

Below are the number of active sites as of December 2019 and projection of their extension:

- VCT sites: baseline 185 Year 1 (16), Year 2 (11), Year 3 (11)
- PMTCT sites: baseline 66 assessed (2019) to 166 assessed in 2023
- Treatment sites: baseline 29 "sites à grande cohorte" (2019) to 50 sites (2023)
